What is ASSP?
ASSP stands for Apprenticeship Staff Support Programme. Apprenticeships involve a learner who is employed and working towards completing a qualification in their chosen sector. Success is measured through achievement of their framework. The project aimed to create resources that would support employer staff in supporting apprentices.

Compare and contrast the effectiveness of the TSSP and ASSP resources

What is TSSP?
TSSP stands for Traineeship Staff Support Programme. Traineeships involve a learner (who is not ready for an apprenticeship) undertaking work experience, Maths and English lessons while also increasing their employability skills. The success of these is measured through achievement of an apprenticeship, employment or completion of the planned elements on their Individual Learning Plan. The project aimed to create resources that would support employer staff in supporting trainees.

- ## Recommendations
1. Further dissemination the ASSP project to raise awareness of the resources
 2. Pilot TSSP resources with a larger group of learners and employers, and analyse their feedback
 3. Review ITC processes facilitating a greater link with employers using resources

Key findings

It would seem there is room for improvement with both sets of resources. The resources themselves seem to be effective as indicated by the learner feedback. Further research needs to be undertaken with a larger group to ensure it can be quantified. However the awareness of them and the process of using them will need to be reviewed, as indicated by the employer and staff feedback to make them more effective in delivery.

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
